The Benefits...

- The district requires and pays for complete physical exams on a regular basis.
- All firefighters are covered by Workers' Compensation whenever they are performing duties for the district.
- An additional Sickness and Accident Insurance pays benefits in addition to Workers' Compensation.
- The district pays the monthly premiums for the State Volunteer Fireman's Pension Fund for all active volunteers.
- Each of the volunteer organizations receive payment for each of their members each time they respond to a call or attend a regular training. The organizations then use this money to fund dinners, picnics, scholarship programs for member's children, and to purchase items like coats, shirts, and hats for their members.
